The New Brunswick Federation of Music Festivals held their 43rd Provincial Music Festival this past week, June 4-7 in Sackville, New Brunswick. Approximately 85 young musicians from around the province, who had been recommended as their local festival representatives by the adjudicators at those festivals, competed in the four-day competitive festival. This year we were pleased to have representation from eight local festivals.

The NB Federation of Music Festivals, the umbrella organization for the twelve local festivals around the province, sponsors the NB Provincial Music Festival which is under the direction of the Executive Director, Barbara Long, President Nadine Lane, and a Board of Directors made up of representatives from various local festivals. The Marjorie Young Bell Conservatory, Mount Allison University, was the venue for three levels of competition.
